How to complete the player registration

- For Japanese teams

Please complete the player registration and make payment through the JFDA Membership Website before the deadline. After the registration, please make payment as soon as possible. You are allowed to cancel your registration only if you contact JFDA before the player registration deadline, and the player fee (excluding the system usage fee) will be reimbursed. All bank fees are at the cost of the player.

- For Non-Japanese teams

Please inform us the number of players in your team before the deadline so that we can send out the invoice. To secure your bid, please make payment of the player fees before the deadline. Details will be announced after the team registration is closed.

Spectator Guide
